

Password Change

- Go to <http://arnold.hssd.k12.wi.us:8000/cgi-bin/index.cgi>
- Login with your username and password
- Select Preferences then Security
- The Barracuda Spam Firewall assigns you a random password the first time you access it, or the first time you receive a quarantined message.
- If you want to change the password that it selected, you may visit the Security screen and set up a new password for yourself.
- At this time there is no way to "cache" or remember the password so that you don't have to retype it.
- Change the password to one that you will easily remember.
- We cannot recover passwords.
