

Quarantine Enable/Disable

- Go to <http://arnold.hssd.k12.wi.us:8000/cgi-bin/index.cgi>
- Login with your username and password
- Select Preferences then Quarantine Enable/Disable
- You may enable or disable the quarantine feature.
- If you don't want the Barracuda Spam Firewall to "catch" messages that it finds offensive and store them on its hard disk, you may disable the quarantine feature.
- If you disable quarantine, all your mail will just be sent to your email program on your computer.
