

Spam Filtering Enable/Disable

- You may enable or disable the spam scanning feature.
- The Barracuda Spam Firewall scans all messages for offensive subjects, known scams, and can scan for some words in the body of the message.
- If you do not want it to scan your incoming messages, you may turn off spam scanning here.
