

Whitelist/Blacklist

- Go to <http://arnold.hssd.k12.wi.us:8000/cgi-bin/index.cgi>
- Login with your username and password
- Select Preferences then Whitelist/Blacklist
- In the Whitelist/Blacklist tab, you may add in email addresses that you always wish to receive or always wish to block.
- You may also block entire domains, so if you never want to receive any mail from Yahoo, you could put in "yahoo.com" in the "blocked" area, click the "Add" button, and the Barracuda box would block any mail from "yahoo.com".
